 - Riparian enhancements
 - Flood plain and side channel restorations
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- 1.2 Need NRCS Conservation Practices Implemented since 2011
- 1.3 Critical Areas intersection with Agricultural Activities
 - Identify Acreage per critical area
 - Identify baseline Acreage and Current Status of Designated Agricultural lands
 - Farmland Protection Program 2011 Baseline: % in open space, % in long term Ag.
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- 1.4 Identify specific Ag land ownership for lands intersecting critical areas
- 1.5 Need identification of specific Critical areas of concern from NRCS, Conservation Commission, WDFW and Ecology associated with Ag activities..

- Provide for benchmarks the landowner will maintain or attain through his VSP
