To those who find value in family/children,

I have sent a prior letter identifying reasons why the marijuana operation are not suitable for neighborhoods and have recently faced other reasons as to why they should not be allowed in such places. From the meetings I have attended with the county commissions, I hear those associated with the facilities voicing that they have attempted to be a part of the neighborhood and do good for the area! This is absolutely a lie and cover up to who they really are and what they represent! The actions that I have encountered in the last week in our neighborhood (and you would suspect them to be on their best behavior at this time) has been absolutely the opposite of those demanding respect and fair treatment.

Sunday, April 17th-we took our family down to Aeneas lake (on North Pine Creek) like we have done so many times over the last 12 years since we have been residents to this area. We encountered an individual camped down by the lake tucked back in the bushes. Our dogs barked (German short hair and black lab puppy) and a vicious bark came from the camp site. Of course, we quickly retreated the dogs and was told from the individual there that we had a very nice looking dog and it would be unfortunate if we didn't keep our dogs away and his tore ours up! Very neighborly, especially where we had our 5 year old with our older kids enjoying the ducks and turtle and peaceful waters of the lake. Had that dog "accidentally" come unleashed, it would have destroyed not only our dog, but no doubt in my mind a dog labeled as such, would have destroyed our child as well.

Saturday, April 23 @ 8 am-I went for a run from my house down the straight stretch to horse spring coulee. I thought maybe at this time in the morning on the weekend there would be significantly less traffic as it has always been in the past! Unfortunately, the grow operations must have set their Saturday hours starting around 8 am as I encountered significantly more vehicles that I have ever seen on a Saturday morning on this road and the driver's, having seen them pull directly out of the operations, drove faster than legally allowed or needed and I actually had two vehicles not even cross over the yellow line to go around me while running on a very small shoulder. I was over as far as I could without running directly down in the ditch! You could clearly see that no one was coming and they could have easily moved over, but chose not too! I can deal with disrespect and always have my guard up, but are we suppose to take away the luxury from our children of walking or riding their bikes on a road that has always catered to the runners, bikes, elderly and mother's pushing baby strollers

(which I passed almost everyday going to work) to those who are only here for the money and not our family! This shouldn't be tolerated!

Saturday, April 23 @ 4 pm- My youngest daughter (11), her good friend (10) and my youngest son (5), begged to go to the lake to see if they could find any turtles and put their feet in to see how cold the water was. As we pulled in, there were three adults there that were questionable enough that I actually sat there in the car debating whether or not to even let the children out. They appeared harmless, but I just felt uneasy. The kids pointed out the one guy was dancing and twirling splashing in the water and was now taking his shirt off in the bushes and luckily headed out of sight. The woman (surely could not be called a lady with her inappropriate behavior) asked my children their ages as I kept an eye that she kept her distance on the other side of the bush that separated the two groups. They respectfully said their ages and she point out that she had four kids with a slurring non-flowing gesture action and then proceeded to say the "F" word several times as she incoherently tried to act through a conversation that we could understand so very little of (she had no children with her for what appeared to be a good reason). She then proceeded to start yelling the other man's name to bring her sweater because she as cold, yet she was standing thigh deep in the lake in the middle of April. When he finally responded, he walked to the edge of the water and told her he wasn't going to bring it in to her, she purposely tipped over backwards and went all the way under the water. She came up eventually and continued talking about how cold she was! I had seen enough in a very short amount of time and unfortunately their acts absolutely took away from the reasons we moved here! When we got to the car, the friend of my daughter asked why the woman was touching herself and looking down her shirt making moaning sounds. You should try explaining this! I took the opportunity to explain to the kids why we don't do drugs, but that should not have been what they had taken from the trip to the lake!

The operators could argue that these people are not associated with them, but ***these are the people they are bringing and promoting with the drug world that they represent regardless! You tell me the people they are bringing to our neighborhoods and our communities are not negatively affecting the rest us trying to raise families with values and morals!*** It is absolutely ridiculous that this is even happening because people value the money they are making over the families this community is raising.
