As you folks deliberate, I want to share a pic of the lots for sale about 3 miles up North Pine Creek from Tonasket where they have been trying to develop a rural residential neighborhood...

I have annotated where the marijuana grow operations are currently located in relation to those lots... We fear that any marijuana grow operation could purchase these lots, as they did vacant fields and set up their industry (not agriculture, not farming) smack dab in the middle of this.

I can not show how large the Enterprise grow operation is - but it is bordered on 3 sides by residential homes.

Please consider NIMBY - Not in my back yard - literally is pine creek is turning into marijuana drive... Of the 30 grow operations registered in/around Tonasket 98855 - greater than 1/3 of them are <5 miles from town on north pine creek.

Please consider this, and my other communications in regards to our concerns for our "neighborhoods" as we know the pro-pot camp has revamped the Okanogan County Codes to remove neighborhood character and light/noise/traffic/smell concerns from neighbors, etc... in their draft to be considered by you.
