Determination of Significance replaced by Determination of Non-Significance? Hmm/I don't think so.

Quality of life/water/air/development/communities/landscape surroundings/and on and on/across the County/and in my home area of the Methow Valley. Determination of Significance replaced by Determination of Non-Significance? Hmm/I don't think so.

A more thoughtful approach to the direction of future growth in the Methow and the County would seem quite evidently a good decision.

Anyone with enough time to pay even a little attention to County issues knows there are multiple over-lapping and inconsistent factors in the current Comp Plan draft proposal. For example/water over-allocation in the lower Methow. For example/overlapping and inconsistent and inadequate protections for ground water sources. For example/zoning ambiguities.

The contradictory parts of the Comprehensive Plan, Zoning Ordinance and supporting documents need reconciliation, and definitions provided, before adoption of these plans.
