Hi,

A minor and fairly specific request when thinking about future growth as it relates to the Patterson Lake area. This is a popular destination for visitors year round for swimming, boating, fishing, skating, etc. and usage seems to be increasing consistently. Patterson Lake Road to Chickadee and Sun Mountain that parallels the eastern shore of the lake has a speed limit of 50 mph which I think is much too high. In the summer, families park and walk along the road making passing cars a serious danger. In the winter the road is icy making driving a bit dicey especially since many visitors are from warmer climates and don't travel on slick roads often. Finally, the noise from cars traveling at 50+ seriously detracts from the tranquility of the lake.

When looking ahead to more visitors in the future, I think a 30-35 mph limit along that short stretch will go a long way towards preserving the safety and serenity of the area.
