**Subject:** Scoping Issues

The following is very important to me and I want the County to take these into consideration during the scoping process:

- \* Space for wildlife: this includes migration corridors where animals (not just mule deer) can find food, including hunting for food, mating and birthing places, and travel from ecosystem to ecosystem away from settlements and homes, undisturbed.
- \* Water resources: not only protecting riparian areas but protecting upland snowpack for recharging water resources and stream flow.
- \* Rural quality of life: this is the reason people move here and tourism is such a strong economic engine here. Maintain large tracts of land and sufficient acreage requirements for building so that the visual effect is wide open spaces in the hills surrounding towns. Not hillsides dotted with lot of homes! Maintain 20 acre minimums surrounding towns!
