We appreciate the extension to the comment period on the scope of the EIS for the latest revision to the county's Comprehensive Plan and Zoning regulations. My wife and I respectively urge you to incorporate into the draft EIS the fourth alternative put forth by the Methow Valley Citizens Council. We believe that incorporation of this fourth alternative will serve the people of our county best to mitigate likely harmful impacts of the existing proposed alternatives. Especially important to us are the increasing harmful effects of wildfires, lower snow pack, and water availability. Alternative 4 provides, we feel, sufficient detail in Comp Plan policies to direct growth at a large scale, but recognizing that other regulations have important roles in making land use decisions on a site by site basis.
