Dear MR Huston and County Commissioners,

Scoping for the Environmental Impact Statement is important to me, as I see the new Comprehensive Plan as providing the key guidelines for our future. I would encourage the scoping and Plan to provide as much detail as possible for future guidance, rather than merely providing generalities that will be easy to subvert. The priorities I feel the scoping and Plan should address include;

1. Placing water high on the list, including making sure development does not outrun water supply, protecting County water from appropriation by non-Okanogan downstream interests, and taking natural, non-human used of water into consideration.

2. Wildfire preparedness. Thus must be considered and taken seriously, and include individual, business, industrial and firefighter provisions.

3. Simple planning through zoning ordinances will not achieve enough detail to direct the growth of the County.

4. Maintain the rural character of the County when major industrial or commercial interests come up.
