I did submit a public comment on the draft Comp Plan, although the Comp Plan itself was difficult to follow and seemed poorly organized. When I then began working on a comment to submit for the DEIS, the confusion and inconsistencies between the 2 documents became even more difficult. I ended up going to the Planning Commission's public hearing in Okanogan to listen and try to better understand the process.

Public comment recommended at the Planning Commission's meeting that the planning process needed to be turned over to a responsible and qualified professional consultant, and that seems a good idea. I now see in the newspaper that the Planning Commission and County Commissioners are in fact going to move in that direction and outreach for a qualified professional. Good.

I will wait for redrafts of the Comp Plan and the DEIS to make further public input but at this time would like to support the inclusion of some secondary documents as attachments to the main Comp Plan. Those inclusions would be Methow Valley More Completely Planned Areas, the Critical Areas Ordinance, the Zoning Ordinance, the Shorelines Management Plan. Since all of these documents are interrelated and work back and forth with one another, having them all in one place is sensible and important.
