A few comments on the comprehensive plan. We would like to support alternative four with some possible adjustments. One would be the formation of a subunit from the area of Gold Creek South to the mouth of the River. We would also like to see the County hire a professional land-use planner to aid in the process of the comprehensive plan. The availability of water should exclude any industrial use. The water should be saved for agriculture as it is our main support. Lot size on the valley floor should be 10 acres and lot size on the upper benches 40 acres. There should be a moratorium on building permits on the tributaries and upper benches until the water availability issue can be determined. All back roads should be kept open for access to fire and for use as escape routes for homeowners. If the gravel plant is established near the town of Methow crushing and hauling should be limited to daytime use only. We sincerely hope that this time the County commissioners will not throw out all of our input as was done a few years ago.
